The Northern Ontario Hockey Association (NOHA) is seeking applications for the position of Director of Scouting for Team NOHA. There is one (1) position available.

The Team NOHA Director of Scouting reports to the Team NOHA Management Committee, and works in cooperation with the NOHA Technical Director, who will handle the team's administrative duties. It is a volunteer position. The term for this position runs until the completion of OHL Cup (Potentially one additional event in the spring)

Purpose

The purpose of Team NOHA is to help showcase the top OHL Priority Selection Eligible Players (2007-born) in Northern Ontario at showcase events during the 2022/2023 season.

Events

The events Team NOHA will be attending are the following:

- OHL Cup, this event is typically held at the end of March and is hosted in Toronto.
- The NOHA is hopeful be involved in three (3) additional events, (November, February, May). This will be confirmed as soon as possible.

General

The Director of Scouting must currently have Respect in Sport – Activity Leader or Speak Out Certification and the Gender Diversity Course. They must have a valid Criminal Record Check with VSS. The candidate must have previous experience evaluating players, and be well connected amongst the scouts, specifically within Northern Ontario.

Must be available for the event listed above, as well as the GNU18L Playoffs scheduled for mid-March, 2023. The candidate must be available to lead the player evaluation efforts throughout the 2022/2023 season.

- Will collect player feedback from members of the scouting community.
- The candidate must be able to work effectively with the Management Committee, NOHA Technical Director, Coaching Staff, Trainers, Players, and Parents.
- In collaboration with the Team NOHA Staff, and Team NOHA Management Committee, will be responsible for the selection of Team NOHA for the OHL Cup.
- Other tasks as assigned.
