The Northern Ontario Hockey Association is inviting applications for the full-time position of **Technical Director**. The position will receive direction from the Executive Director. This position is located in the Association's office located in North Bay, Ontario.

Responsibilities

Reporting to the Executive Director, the Technical Director:

- Shall be responsible for coordination and administration of Development Programs and materials within the NOHA in concert with the NOHA Development Committee.
- Responsible for providing additional learning opportunities for coach and trainer development within the NOHA through professional development clinics and learning resources.
- Shall be responsible for communicating and implementing changes made by the Ontario Hockey Federation, Hockey Canada, the Hockey Trainers Ontario (HTO), and the Coaching Association of Canada (CAC) related to the NOHA's development programs.
- Shall be responsible for planning and executing NOHA Development Clinics, working in consultation with the District Council Directors, Learning Facilitators, Field Evaluators, Associations, and Municipalities.
- Shall be responsible for hosting and providing support for player development initiatives such as Skills Camps, Grassroots Festivals, and First Shift Programs.
- Shall be responsible for the planning and execution of the NOHA Player Development Weekend.
- Shall be the staff resource for Team NOHA (U16 Team).
- Shall be the primary contact with the public on all development matters within the NOHA, in person and by phone, e-mail and/or video conference.
