Ontario Not-for-Profit Corporations Act (ONCA)

- Came into force October 19, 2021
- Sets out the legal rules governing Ontario non-profit entities
- Goal –improve transparency and accountability in non-profit entities

Applicability to NOHA

- Associations must incorporate
- Associations must file a tax return annually (within 6-months of year-end)
- Financial review requirements –depending on gross income

Financial Review Requirements

- Gross income under \$100k –compilation engagement
- Gross income between \$100k & \$500k -review engagement
- Gross income over \$500k –audit engagement



Wherever business takes you

MNP.ca

Engagement fees

- Compilation engagement -\$3,000 to \$7,000
- Review engagement -\$7,000 to \$12,500
- Audit engagement -\$12,500 to \$25,000
- Bookkeeping available if needed –billed separately



Rep Team Applications

- Will be shared next week
- Eligible Team list will be included to each Association
- Includes Leave of Absence and eligibility to host Team based on progression
- Progressive Teams require NOHA Board approval
- Applications are due by March 15



End of Season Reconciliation

- Will start after February 10th – last day to register participants
- Overpayment will be refunded; additional fees will require invoices to be sent
- Will include, where requested, invoices for game sheets or other invoices
- Goal – to be completed by end of March (fiscal year end)





- **Users will be given access to premium version of the app**



Maltreatment Update

- **Continued support from Associations and Teams around maltreatment education**
- **Please ensure that allegations of discrimination in game are reported to the Official(s) so that they can be reported appropriately**
- **All other allegations of maltreatment/misconduct must be reported to the Independent Third Party (ITP) as a first step; Association has the right to suspend on an interim basis**



Seasonal Calendar for 26/27

- Coaches can be announced as of **February 15, 2026**
- Players may register for Player Evaluations as of **April 1, 2026**
- Preparation Skates can be delivered beginning as of **March 2** and end **April 17 (U11/U13)** and **April 19 (U15/U18)**
- Must be offered by Associations delivering Spring Evaluations -
 - 4 skills sessions minimum - players are not required to attend
 - Eligibility - Attend your current Association prep skates, or if they are not offered, may attend skates of any other Member (i.e. HL Association, or Association that runs Fall Evaluations)
 - Evaluation start dates
 - AAA - April 18 (U11/U13) and April 20 (U15/U18)
 - AA - April 25 (U11/U13) and April 27 (U15/U18)
 - A and below - May 2



Player Evaluation Survey

- Our goal - to offer evaluations in all centres across the NOHA in the Spring
- Why - hosting Spring evaluations in one Association and a neighbouring Association hosting evaluations in the Fall can create a disadvantage to the organization hosting Fall tryouts
- The challenge - ice comes out in many locations in late-March, early-April; Associations run non-traditional programming instead of evaluations



The Data

- **9 of 22 Associations that responded lose ice before the current evaluation structure ends the first week of May**
- **The majority of Associations could host Spring evaluations up to early April**
- **$\frac{2}{3}$ of Associations already deliver Spring evaluations**
- **$\frac{2}{3}$ of Associations also report losing players to other Associations due to the timing of their evaluations**



Next Steps

- Share feedback with the Board of Directors and determine next steps
- Determine the need to have consistency in player evaluation dates based on the feedback
- If needed, develop a plan, in consultation with Associations, to host Spring Evaluations
- Due to timing and the work involved, this would likely not impact us until 2027



Quick Hits - Reminders

- **Dressing Room Supervision Policy** - 2 screened adults inside or directly outside the dressing room with the door ajar
- **Photos in dressing room** - NOHA policy does not permit cell phones or photography in the dressing room
- **Helmets for Coaches** - OHF policy has been amended; fine and suspension to Coach for 1st infraction (previously a warning provided)
